UNC Weeknight Parking Program Details

Program began August 15, 2019

**Affects parking after 5pm at the
FedEx Global Education Center**

Beginning August 15, weeknight parking on UNC's campus requires a permit or hourly/nightly fee from 5 p.m. on Mondays — 7:30 a.m. Fridays. Parking will remain available on the weekends without a permit or additional fee, from 5 p.m. Friday—7:30 a.m. Monday.

The parking lot under the FedEx Global Education Center is included in the Weeknight Parking Program. The lot will still be open to the public after 5pm weekdays, but visitors must pay for their parking at the pay station next to the elevators on P1. Parking per night is \$1. There are [several options](#) for payment, including on the ParkMobile app, over the phone, on the ParkMobile website, and at the pay station. **Please reach out to us at europe@unc.edu if you have questions about parking and our evening events at the Center.**

Specific Guidelines for UNC-CH Weeknight Parking

VISITORS

- Visitors may park in designated, unreserved lots across campus for \$1/night or utilize metered spaces across campus.
- Visitors may obtain a [\\$1 temporary one-night pass](#) through the ParkMobile App using zone 4500, ParkMobile phone number (877-727-5301), ParkMobile [website](#), or a designated weeknight pay station.
- Instructional signage will be posted in designated lots.

STUDENTS

- UNC Daytime permit holders may park on campus at night for no additional cost. Daytime permit holders are not restricted to the daytime lot assignment after 5 p.m. and may park in any unreserved lot designated for weeknight parking.
- Students without a UNC daytime permit may [register their license plate online for access to weeknight parking](#) (no additional cost at registration, first-year undergraduate students are not eligible).

EMPLOYEES

- UNC Daytime permit holders will be able to park on campus at night for no additional cost. Daytime permit holders are not restricted to their daytime lot assignment after 5 p.m. and may park in any unreserved lot.
- Employees who work between 5 p.m. and 7:30 a.m. may purchase a weeknight parking permit based on [sliding scale](#) through their Department Parking Coordinator.
- Daytime employees without a UNC daytime permit who return to campus frequently can buy an annual weeknight parking permit for \$25. This includes Postdoctoral Fellows.
- Commuter Alternative Program (CAP) members are eligible for 20 free weeknight passes.
- Non-permit holders may park in designated, unreserved lots across campus for \$1/night.
